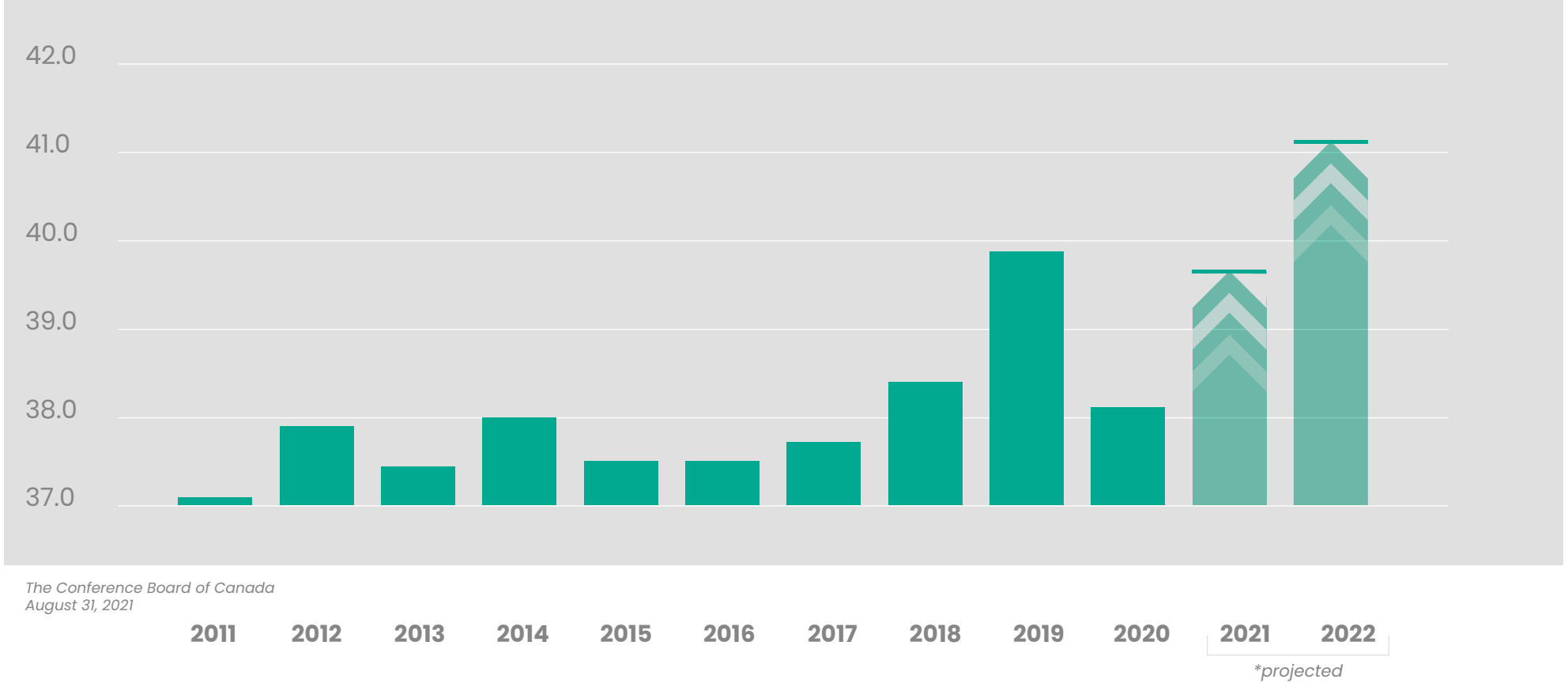

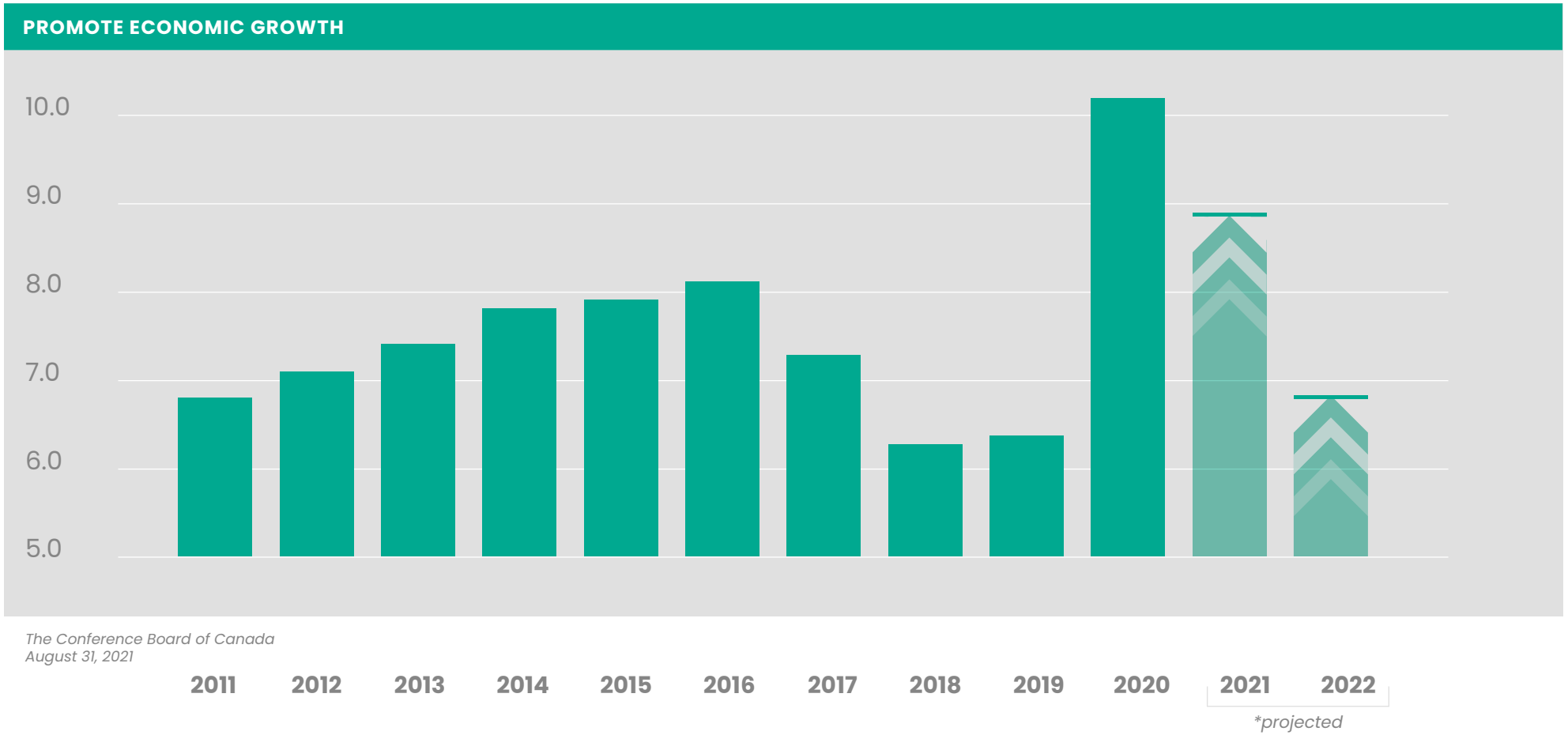

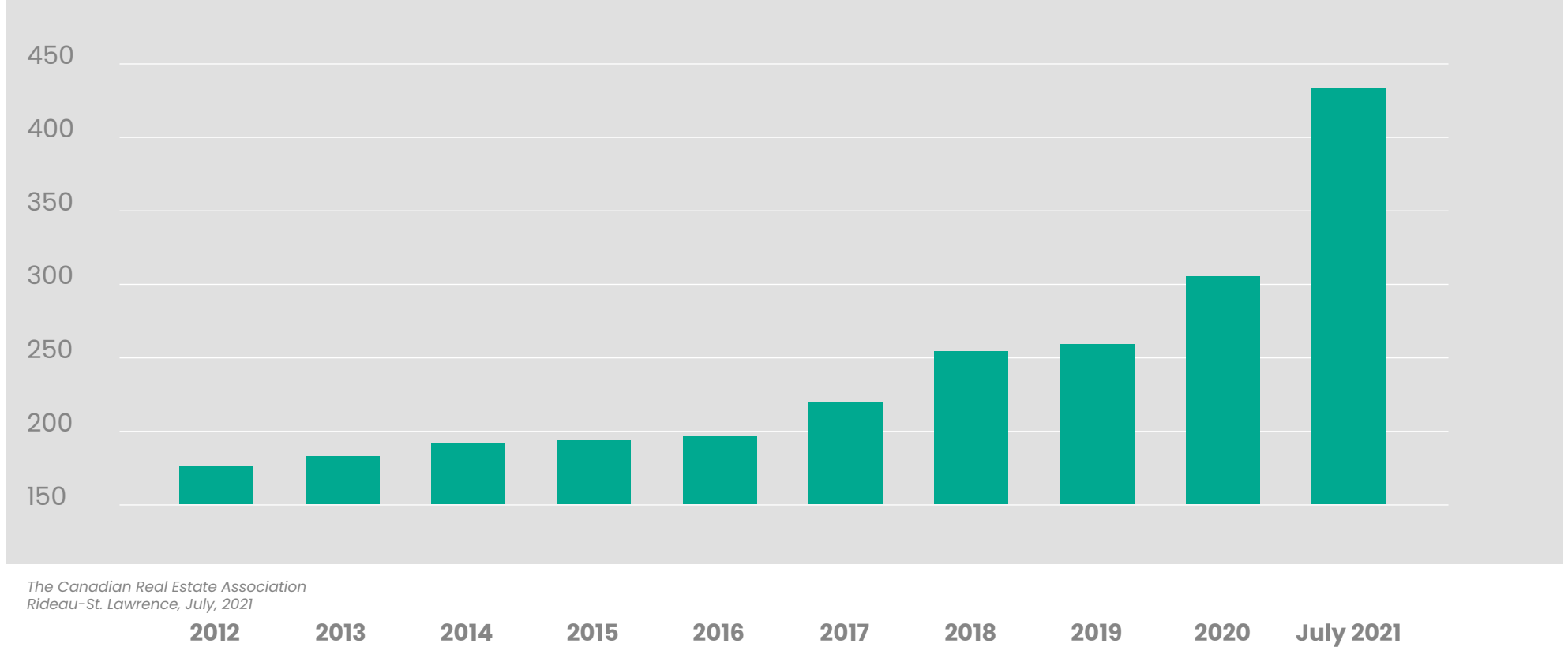


# Avg Residential Housing Price

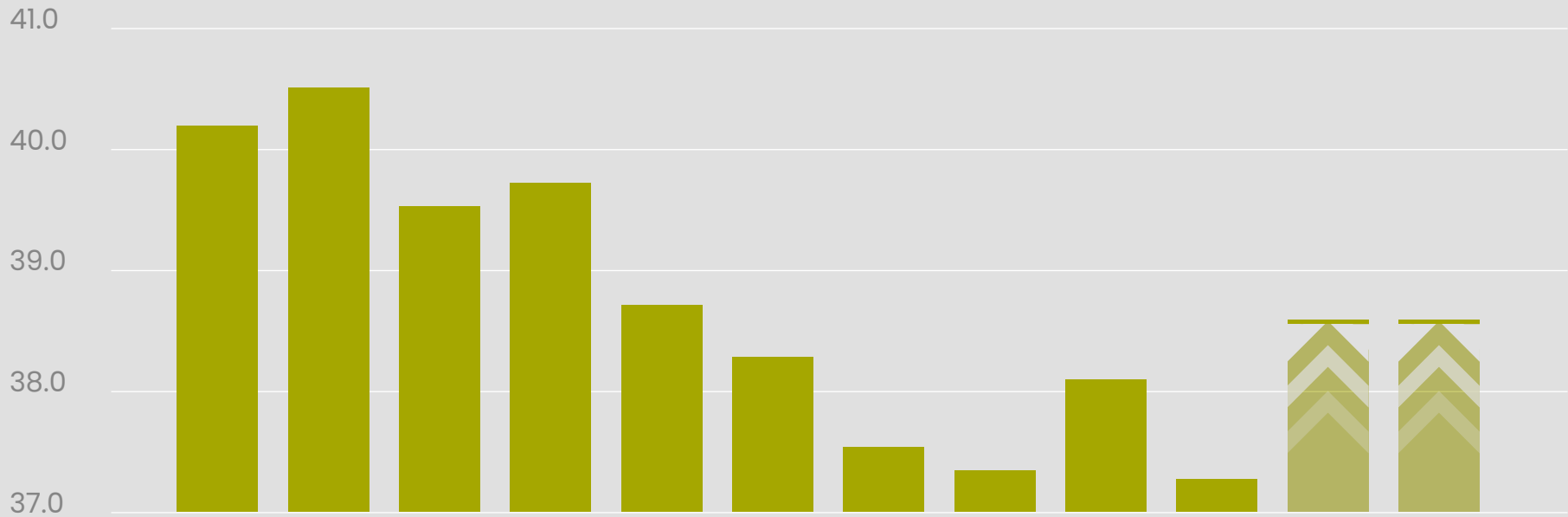


# Labour Force

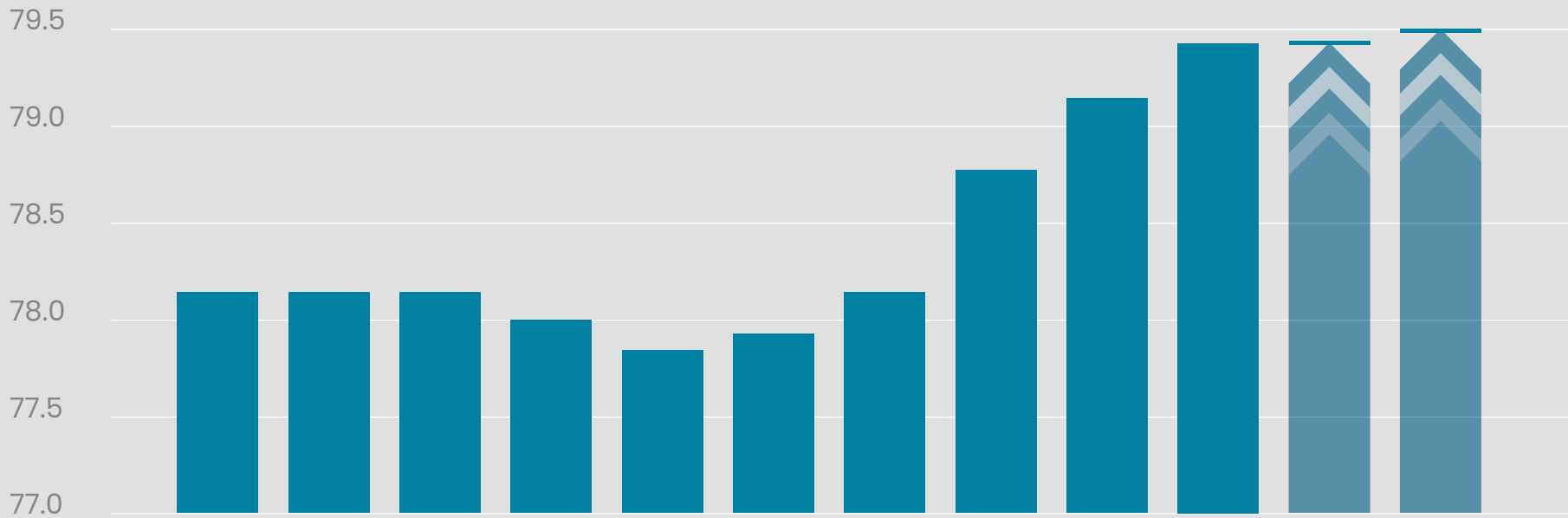
